

A STATEMENT FROM THE PRESIDENT: OUR VISION

Before our organization began, our founder Deborah Krupp was unable to return to her successful engineering career due to a Traumatic Brain Injury (TBI). She eventually connected with an expert medical team in Louisville, KY who used neurorehabilitation to "wake up" the creative centers of her brain. With this, she was able to go from being an engineer to an artist, finding new purpose in her life after her TBI.

Quickly, we identified a need within the brain and spinal injury community: Lives could be drastically improved simply by helping more patients like Deborah enter neurorehabilitation programs. This idea quickly expanded to patients of other neurological conditions who benefit from the same treatment modalities.

With a desire to "pay it forward" to other patients overcoming serious neurological issues, Gemassist Brain Awareness Foundation was born.

We believe our 2022-2033 year to be a successful one. During this time, we've expanded our reach to more patients with the launch of a financial assistance program and by adding a comprehensive directory of neurorehabilitative care providers throughout the United States. Locally, Gemassist became a Generous Supporter of the U of L Health System by financially giving to our local neurorehabilitation center, The Frazier Rehab Institute.
